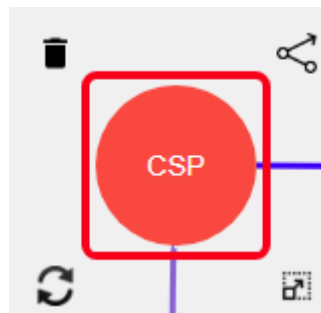
1 Enhancements

1.1 Ecosystem Designer





One of the most commonly used and important modules in CurateFx, the Ecosystem Designer, has been updated to include several significant enhancements that will help users to improve the display and communications of their Business Ecosystem.

1.1.1 Element Manager

The Element Manager Is a tool menu that appears around the outside of a selected element (e.g. Stakeholder) in the Ecosystem.

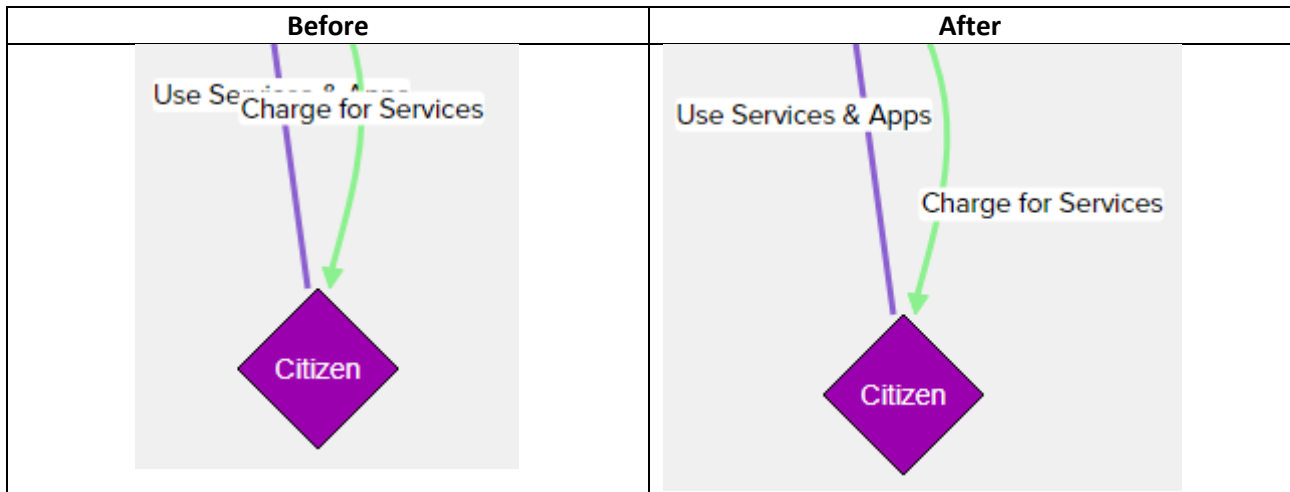


It provides the user with ability to:

	Delete the selected element
	Rotate the selected element
	Create a link/relationship from the current element to another element in the Ecosystem
	Increase or decrease the size of the element shape

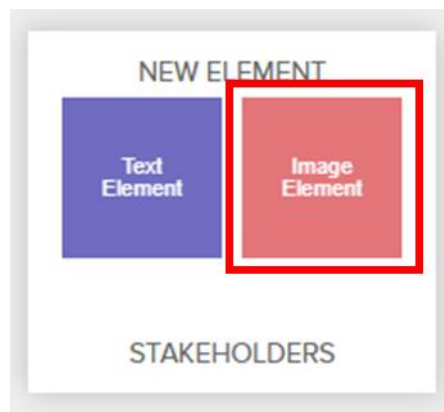
1.1.2 Move Relationship Label

Users can now reposition relationship labels to prevent them from overlapping or been hidden by other labels. Just click and drag the label to the new location.



1.1.3 Add Image Element

Users can now add images as elements in to the Ecosystem. These images can be used for company or product logos.

Once you drag the Image Element in to the Ecosystem, an Insert Image into Ecosystem dialogue box is displayed.

Select the Choose File to select the image you wish to insert and then click Upload image to upload the image.



The Image element can be rotated, resized, deleted and linked to other items in the ecosystem in the same way as any other item

The text label for the image can be edited or removed, and the Send to Back and the send to Front buttons can be used to position the image behind or in front of other items in the Ecosystem

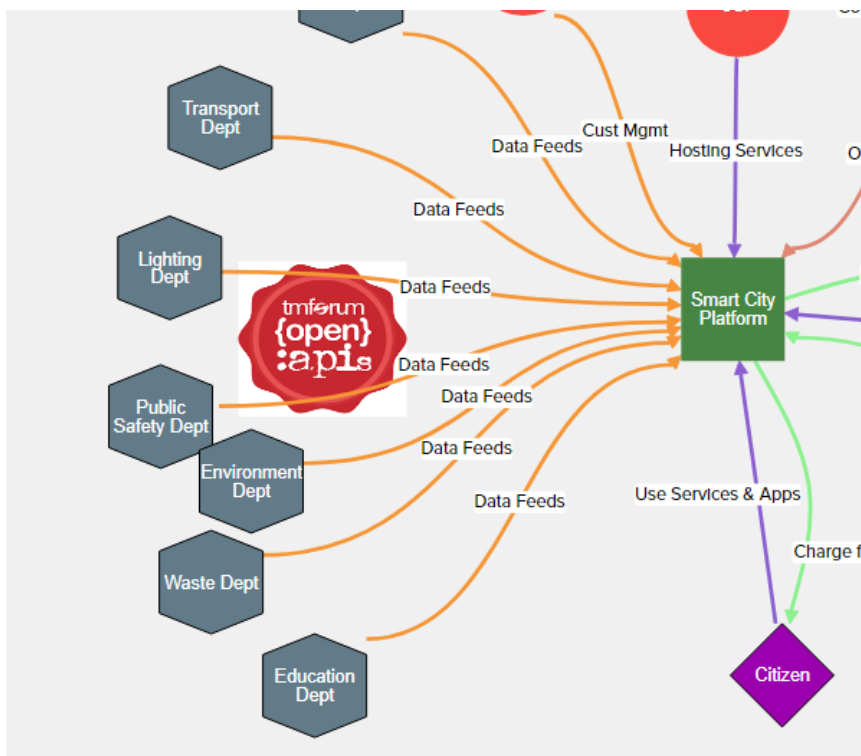
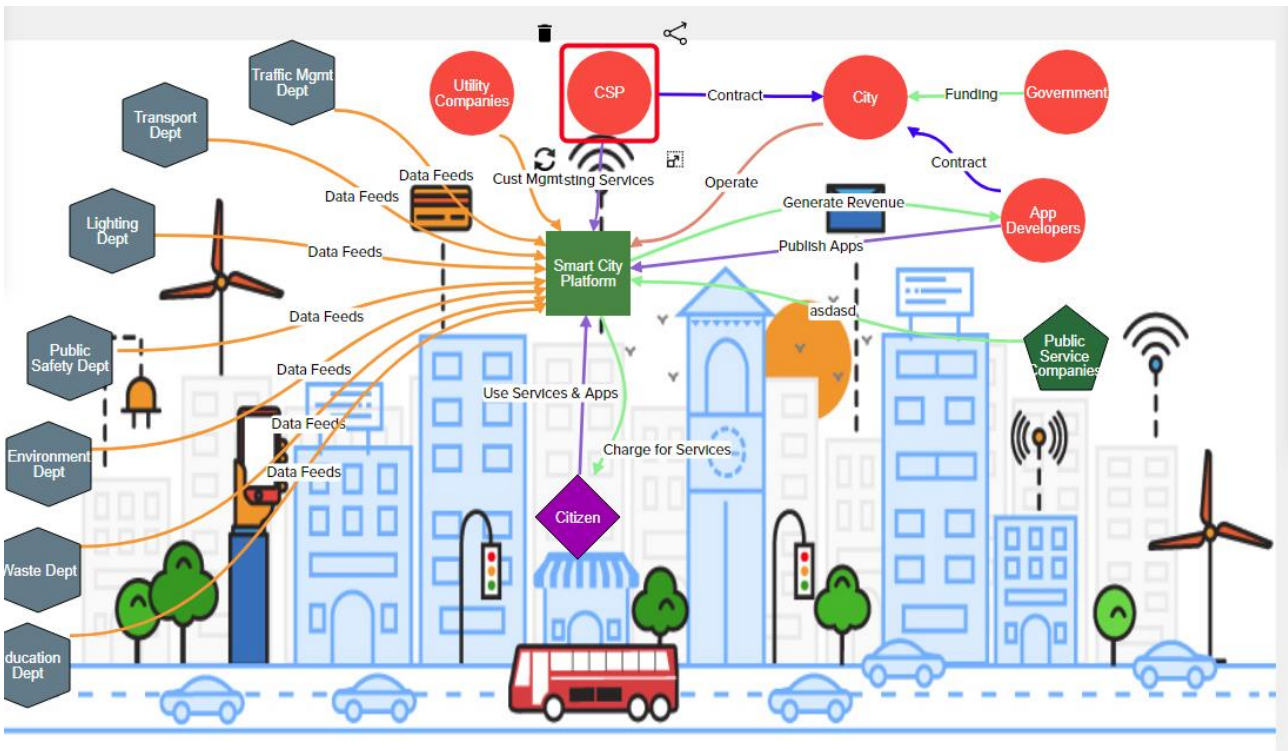


Image elements can also be used to provide a background to the ecosystem. In the example below a Smart City image was added, resized and then Sent to Back.



1.1.4 Change Ecosystem Background Color

To enhance the look of the Ecosystem it is now possible to change the background color for the ecosystem. On the menu bar, next to comments is the Background button.



Once the Background button is clicked it will display the following dialogue box.

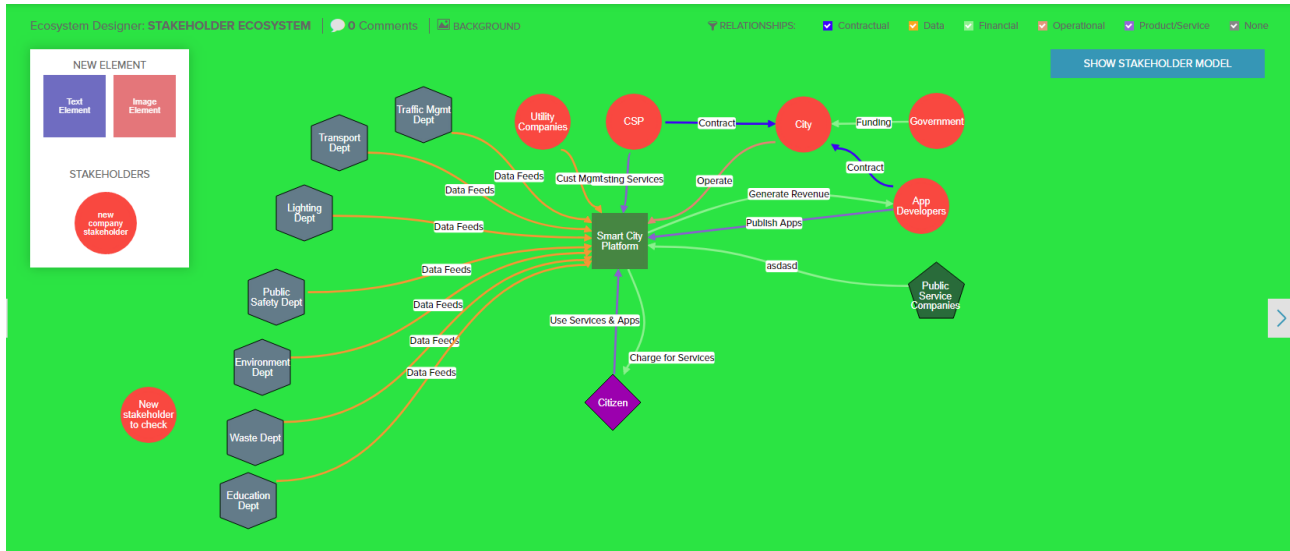
RESET BACKGROUND

At the bottom of this dialogue users are able to use the Color Picker to select a color.

Click the Change Background Color to apply the selected color to the ecosystem background.



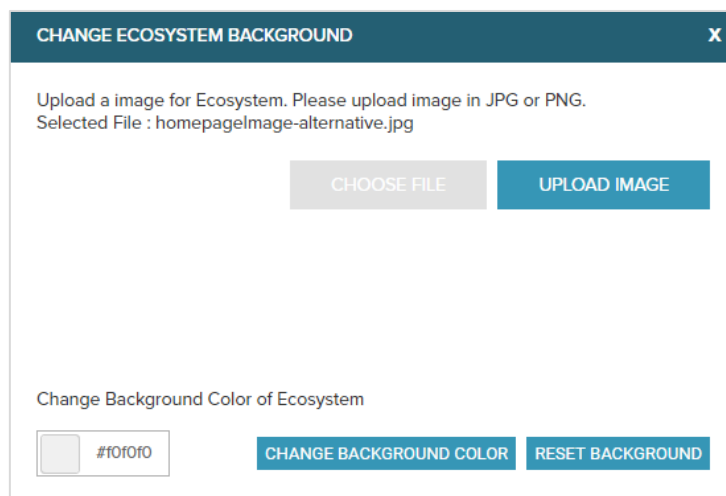
To reset the color, click the background button and click the Reset Background button.

Change Background Color of Ecosystem



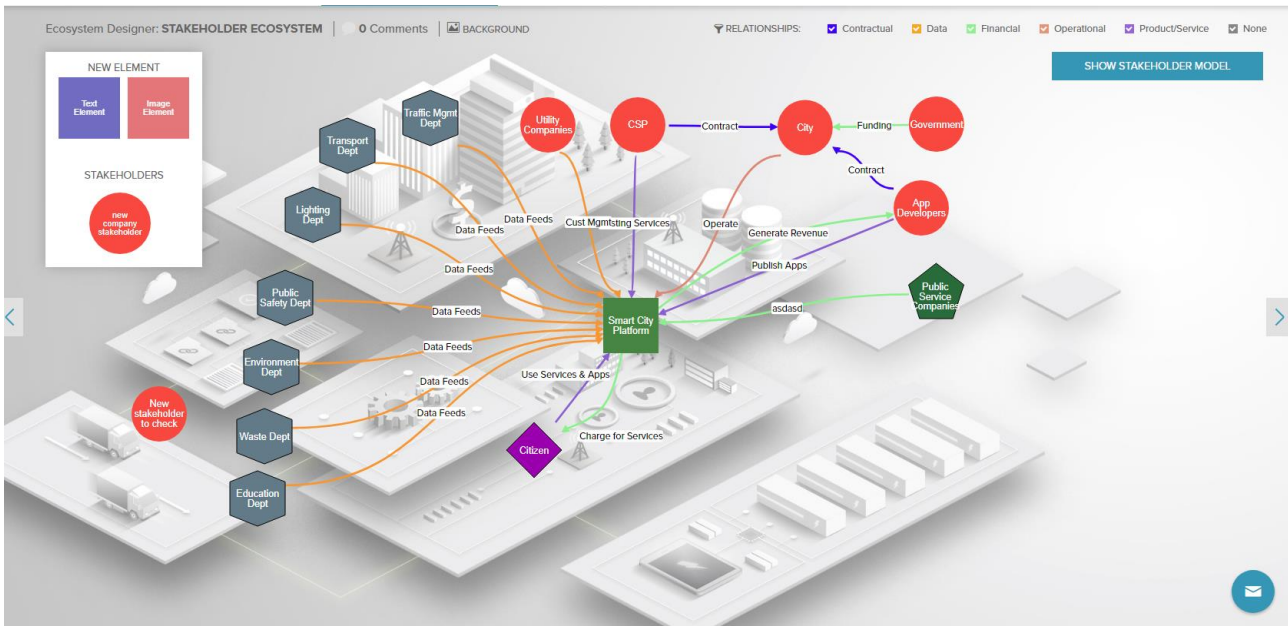
1.1.5 Add Image as Ecosystem Background

It is also now possible to upload an image as the ecosystem background. Click on the Background button and select an image.



Click the Upload Image button to have the image assigned as the Ecosystem Background.

The image now fills the entire background area of the ecosystem.



To remove the Background Image, click the Background button and then click the Reset background button.

1.2 Use Case Module - Color Picker available

The Use Case module now includes a Color Picker to enable users to choose any color they wish for a Use Case Element.




1.3 Business Canvas Color Tag Labels displayed on Mouse Hover

The user defined labels for Color Tags in all Business Canvas modules are now displayed when you hover the mouse over a color.
